A fine live outing with some top notch performances.

Phineas Newborn Jr 'Here is Phineas' (1958) features one of the lost piano voices of jazz. A coulda-woulda-shoulda-type of musician that positioned his virtuosity in the Oscar Peterson direction, this LP is a testament to his talent.
